

American Attachment – Concept Summary PATENT PENDING

American Attachment ("AA") is a unique, color coding process and system for trailer balls and hitches. The AA system allows users to easily identify the proper size balls to use with various hitches/trailers that have different weight requirements.

SAFETY FIRST. AA's entire concept is designed around safety. A first-time trailer user may think it's ok to attach a 2" hitch to a 1 7/8" ball because it fits, but, it's unsafe. The weight associated with a 2" hitch is likely too excessive for a 1 7/8" ball. At the same time, an experienced trailer user may merely be tired of matching up balls and hitches manually and will use AA as a simple, fast way to easily identify the proper size ball for the hitch they will be attaching.

Overall, AA is the first color coding system to assist anyone from users to law enforcement to ensure the correct size balls are being used with appropriate hitches.

In addition to color coding, the AA system may also include:

- 1) Different size and shapes of balls and hitches (triangle, rectangle, square, etc).
- 2) Luminescent or florescent colors that glow in the dark.
- 3) LED lighting.
- 4) A direct color production process for newly made balls and hitches.
- 5) A retro color product for users to easily and safely color balls and hitches they already own.

At first AA will be in the classic red, white, and blue colors but eventually will also include other Country flag colors for expansion into those areas (Italian, German, etc).
